HIT THE SLOPES

Mt. Snow, Stratton, Bromley, Okemo, Killington, and even the smaller hills are all options to consider for this clue!

To complete this clue, do ONE of the following:

Option A. Take a pic of yourself at the top of your selected peak

Option B. OR take a picture with THREE ski area's signs in this region!



EXPLORE BY FOOT

Choose one of the following:

The far southeast region of Vermont is also called The Shires - beautiful, natural and inspiring! For this clue, get out of the car and stretch your legs by exploring any trail in Bennington. You can find an array of the town's trails here: https://www.bennington.com/

To complete this clue: Take a pic of at least one team member at the trailhead or with a trail sign!



GET ARTSY

Explore the Southern Vermont Arts Center's Sculpture Park & Trails!

To complete this clue: Take a pic of yourself with your favorite sculpture!

Insider tip: If you follow the SVAC trail south, you will eventually join the Blue Summit Trail which can take you up to the top of Equinox Mountain, where on a clear day, you can see into Massachusetts and New Hampshire! Hiking map for this area: https://www.equinoxpreservationtrust.org/mapdown.php

This map also provides "suggested route" information, that can tell you how long various routes may take!

AND you can also drive up Mt. Equinox!



TAKE TO THE WOODS ...

Pack up some Vermont cheese and visit Dorset to do one of the following:

- Walk through Cutler Memorial Forest and take a picture of you and your cheese on one of this trail system's bridges – big or small it doesn't matter
- Visit and take a pic of you, your cheese, and the 110 year old Pinnacle Tower

Both are beautiful ways to enjoy this stunning rural area!

SAY WHAT PUZZLE?

Each item referred to here may be found on foot from the Old Bennington Historic District ... Use the hints to build the clue you must solve...

TO SOLVE THIS CLUE: Provide the HINT 1 on the HINT 2 where Robert Frost's HINT 3 is in HINT 4 HINT 5.

WORD HINTS

- 1. Singular version of the "things" that surround the word corkscrew on the historic marker that you'll find on Main Street just south of the Bennington Museum
- 2. Walk north up Monument Ave from the site of #4 to the corner to find the marker of a historic house, set in stone; 2nd line, 2nd word.



(SAY WHAT PUZZLE? PUZZLE CON'T)

- 3. Find the Vermont historic on the Iron Gate of the Bennington Museum; 5th line (after the title), fifth word
- 4. Fourth full paragraph in the Joint Resolution found on the side of Old First Church. Fourth full paragraph, first sentence, 2nd through 5th words
- 5. The location of clue 4

Insider Tip: For HINT 4, you will find yourself in a cemetery known for its beautiful headstones. We encourage you to stroll around and give these works of art a look!



HISTORY, DELICIOUS HISTORY!

Southwestern Vermont boasts a number of historic sites that host cheesemakers! Visit a site that is over 70 years old.

IT THE EADNA

VISIT THE FARM

The Merck Forest and Farmland Center (MFFC) that is! Explore part of their 30 miles of trails, which include easy walks as well as more difficult/longer hikes. You can find trail information and maps here: https://www.merckforest.org/forest/trails/

To complete this clue: Take a pic of yourself with one of the signs you come across - either on the trail, farm, or anywhere else at MFFC

FIND IT...

Name a Vermont cheesemaker or Vermont cheese whose name contains BOTH
