


INSTRUCTIONS Complete ANY FIVE clues in this packet, then submit your answers/pictures using the instructions provided, and you will be entered into our winner drawing!

And you'll need to wear a mask if you find yourself within 6 feet of anyone else from outside your household (state rules!). Insider tip: If you do this clue by October 11, you can swing by the Waitsfield Farmers Market on any Saturday (through October 10th 9am-1pm) or the Stowe Farmers Market (open through October 11th 10am-2pm) to grab some awesome local cheese to take on your adventure! We recommend reading any signage they have on the way into the market to understand how each one is run to help manage COVID safely at this time!

CLUE 3

TAKE A SLOW STROLL
