

THE hunt northwest CLUE

GET CHEESY

Visit a cheesemaker at ONE of the following locations and take a photo of yourself visiting the cheesemaker/ business location to complete this clue:

(1) A cheesemaker's farmstand or store. You can find cheesemakers' farmstands/ stores on the Vermont Cheese Trail here: https://vtcheese.com/vermont-cheesetrail-map. Please note: Not all makers have farmstands/are open to the public - so do be sure you are visiting one that is labeled "open" on the trail map or uses the 'cheese wedge' icon - which means they are open to visitors IF you call ahead. Using the trail map, you can find their phone numbers to do just that; we recommend calling at least a day in advance if possible - and a few sites may

give you a site tour if you call/plan ahead too (it never hurts to ask!). OR ...

(2) At a local farmers markets. Find a market here: <u>https://nofavt.org/find-</u> organic-local-food/farmers-markets. Insider tip: We recommend reviewing the market online/asking them via email to make sure a cheesemaker is at the market. Not all have cheesemakers present!





A PAIRED EXPERIENCE

This can be chocolate maker, apple orchard, cider producer, wine maker, brewery, jam maker, etc. To complete this clue: Take a pic of your cheese and this pairing location (or a paired item you tried there) and tell us where you visited!

A CLOSER LOOK

The Goodsell Ridge Preserve is an 83 acre outdoor museum on Isle La Motte where you can find some of Vermont's oldest fossils. To complete this clue - visit this unique area and take a pic with yourself and a favorite fossil! Insider Tip: If they have them out, you can explore the Walk Through Time Trail which shares illustrated panels that depict the scientific understanding of the 4.6 billion year history of life on Earth.

LEG STRETCH & LEARNING STOP

Time to dig into Vermont's spectacular fall colors! Take a walk or hike - and along the way, see if you can collect tree leaves from the ground for every color of the ROYGBIV rainbow spectrum. Ground rules: Don't pull them off living trees - watch for/don't collect poison ivy and do be curious about what you see.

To complete this clue: Collect at least 5 leaves of different colors that best represent the spectrum of the rainbow, then take a photo of your leaves to upload as the "answer" to this clue! Hint: Blue leaves are tough to find, but you should be able to find(ish) red, orange, yellow, green, and violet/purple-ish!

Neat insider fact: Did you know that there are 145 different species of trees on Vermont's "big tree" list? Keep an eye for these big flora beasts on your walk, and learn more here: <u>https://fpr.</u> <u>vermont.gov/forest/vermonts-forests/vermont-</u> big-trees





PICNIC TIME...

Though farmed and pastured through the 1800's, Niquette Bay State Park is today a forested waterfront park on Vermont's Champlain Islands. Take a walk through this park's trail systems to find your perfect picnic spot. To complete the clue: Photograph yourself at your favorite view/ spot - be that with flora you love, a beach spot where you take a quick wade to cool off, or a bench that overlooks the lake!

Insider Tip: If you are a Vermont residence and member of your local library, you can check with the library to see if they offer free passes to the state parks - which they sometimes offer for members! And remember: It may be free to join your local *library if you've not already too!*

TAKE IN THE VIEW

Superb biking, walking, gorgeous views, trails, farms, and good food await you along the Island Line Rail Trail. This Trail starts south of downtown Burlington in Oakledge Park, rides along the lakeshore past nature reserves, and eventually can take you off mainland Vermont and to the Lake Champlain Islands (via a bike ferry).
