DURATION This packet is a good fit for those looking for a day trip around the region - estimated to take 3-6 hours to complete for anyone starting in this region, with longer duration for anyone doing longer outdoor adventures. For those pursuing the longer hikes/bike rides, planning for two days may be more appropriate.

GET CHEESY

Visit a cheesemaker at ONE of the following locations and take a photo of yourself visiting the cheesemaker/business location to complete this clue:

(1) A cheesemaker's farmstand or store. You can find cheesemakers' farmstands/ stores on the Vermont Cheese Trail here: https://vtcheese.com/vermont-cheese-trail-map. Please note: Not all makers have farmstands/are open to the public - so do be sure you are visiting one that is labeled "open" on the trail map or uses the 'cheese wedge' icon - which means they are open to visitors IF you call ahead. Using the trail map, you can find their phone numbers to do just that; we recommend calling at least a day in advance if possible - and a few sites may

give you a site tour if you call/plan ahead too (it never hurts to ask!). OR ...

(2) At a local farmers markets. Find a market here: https://nofavt.org/find-organic-local-food/farmers-markets.

Insider tip: We recommend reviewing the market online/asking them via email to make sure a cheesemaker is at the market. Not all have cheesemakers present!



A PAIRED EXPERIENCE

Grab a Vermont cheese and visit the site of an organization that produces something that pairs with cheese! This can be chocolate maker, apple orchard, cider producer, wine maker, brewery, jam maker, etc. To complete this clue: Take a pic of your cheese and this pairing location (or a paired item you tried there) and tell us where you visited!

Each item referred to here may be found on foot from the Old Bennington Historic District ... Use the hints to build the clue you must solve...

TO SOLVE THIS CLUE: Provide the HINT 1 on the HINT 2 where Robert Frost 's HINT 3 is in HINT 4 HINT 5.

WORD HINTS

- 1. Singular version of the "things" that surround the word corkscrew on the historic marker that you'll find on Main Street just south of the Bennington Museum
- 2. Walk north up Monument Ave from the site of #4 to the corner to find the marker of a historic house, set in stone; 2nd line, 2nd word.

- 3. Find the Vermont historic on the Iron Gate of the Bennington Museum; 5th line (after the title), fifth word
- 4. Fourth full paragraph in the Joint Resolution found on the side of Old First Church. Fourth full paragraph, first sentence, 2nd through 5th words
- 5. The location of clue 4

Insider Tip: For HINT 4, you will find yourself in a cemetery known for its beautiful headstones. We encourage you to stroll around and give these works of art a look!



FIND IT...

Pack up some Vermont cheese and visit the 110 year old Pinnacle Tower in Dorset. Take a picture of you and the tower to complete this clue!

GET ARTY

Explore the Southern Vermont Arts Center's Sculpture Park & Trails!

To complete this clue: Take a pic of yourself with your favorite sculpture!

Insider tip: If you follow the SVAC trail south, you will eventually join the Blue Summit Trail which can take you up to the top of Equinox Mountain, where on a clear day, you can see into Massachusetts and New Hampshire! This map also provides "suggested route" information, that can tell you how long various routes may take!





LEG STRETCH & LEARNING STOP

TIME TO HIT THE SLOPES

Mt. Snow, Stratton, Bromley, Okemo, Killington, and even the smaller hills are all options to consider for this one! To complete this clue, take a pic of yourself at the top of one of the peaks in this area.

Insider tip: Most you can hike up - and find trail listings online/at their sites. Some have lifts or gondolas you can take in the summer to enjoy the mountain air at the top with more ease!



PICNIC TIME...

Vermont has quarries all through it! On this stop, you'll explore the Gettysburg Quarry Hike - a climb that takes you through the forest to the Quarry Lookout. Visit Art's Bench for a little rest - and share a pic of you, any cheese you find yourself snacking on, and the view!

TAKE IN THE VIEW

Pick one of the following adventure options and take a pic of yourself on your outing to complete this clue!

Take a drive up the Equinox Mountain Skyline Drive (we love the view and want to just note that the drive requires a fee!).



SEE SOMETHING UNIQUE

Southwestern Vermont boasts a number of historic sites that host cheesemakers! Visit a site that is over 70 years old (doesn't have to be a cheesemaker, though they sure are tasty to visit!).
