NAVIGATION TIPS

-  Attendees must be registered for each individual tour they would like to participate in, **maximum two tours per attendee**. (One tour is often more reasonable as locations can be far apart.) All tour registrations are taken via https://form.jotform.com/Vermont_Cheese/tours2026.
-  We strongly recommend you **refer to the official Farm & Creamery Tour map** and travel time between locations before registering for tours.
-  You are registering for an authentic Vermont experience -- and limited cell reception is an every-day part of life in Vermont. Please remember to **download or print maps and travel directions for off-line use** before you leave for a location.
-  Many farms have provided additional helpful directions and instructions for attendees, which will be sent in an email confirmation.
-  Farms and creameries may have markets or retail spaces listed on Google, but those aren't necessarily their farm or creamery space. **Please use the addresses provided on our map.**
-  Mileage can be deceptive in Vermont; many roads have low speed limits and carry you through many small towns and villages. This is why we've provided this chart below to help you estimate **how long it will take you to travel between tour sites**.
